Our student population is made of 47% Caucasian, 36% African American, 6% Multirace, and 11% Hispanic. One hundred percent of the teachers hold a bachelor's degree and 57% have a master's level or a specialty degree. Difficult economic times have hit the area resulting in buy-out and closing of two local factories. Over the past three years, enrollment has dropped by 3%. While adopting our own unique mission stated in the introduction, we embrace the district mission of providing a safe, disciplined learning environment that empowers all students to develop their full potential. We strongly agree with and uphold the district's belief statement: "In a consistently safe and healthy environment, all students can become responsible, respectful, and resourceful. Two areas of concerns for the school:

Originally, Central High School was a 10-12 campus for 17 years. In the spring of 2020, the school geared up to become a complete four-year high school for the 2020-2021 school year. This transitions in grade-level composition is causing destabilizing effect on relationships among staff.

Overcrowding was never a problem. But now, the population of the school has increased from 800 students to 1,250 students The school now has 12 portable classrooms.
