Create your theme work using Online Design, InDesign, Goggle Slides, or a program approved by your adviser. If you hand draw these designs, then take a photo and upload into your program. It would be great to have all the designs in one place.

Your theme packet should include the following:

- Theme: Identify your theme and write two or three sentences explain the theme and your theme packet (5 Points)
- Spin-offs-Make a list of your spin-offs and be sure to include two of the spin-offs on your dividers. (5 Points)
- Identify your fonts-Use up to three fonts (5 Points)
- Identify your color palette-Use up to five colors) (5 Points)
- Cover-Design your cover with colors, fonts, and graphics (10 Points)
- Front Endsheets-Include elements from the cover and include a table of contents (10 Points)
- Back Endsheets-Include elements from the cover. (5 Points)
- Title Page (Page 1)-Design the page and include at least one photo (10 Points)
- Opening Spread (Pages 2-3)- Design the spread and use photos (10 Points)
- Theme copy for the opening spread-Include the theme copy on the opening spread (5 Points)
- Two Dividers (Divisional Pages)-Dividers should look the same but change the spin-offs and photos (10 Points)
- Closing Spread-Design should look like opening spread but with closing copy and different photos (5 Points)
- Theme copy for the closing spread-Include the closing copy on the closing spread (5 Points)
- One Spread in your yearbook-Choose any spread you like. (10 Points)
